What is Lent?

Lent is the 40 day period of time leading up to Easter and the celebration of the Resurrected Lord. Frederick Buechner helpfully writes: "In many cultures there is an ancient custom of giving a tenth of each year's income to some holy use. For Christians, to observe the forty days of Lent is to do the same thing with roughly a tenth of each year's days. After being baptized by John in the river Jordan, Jesus went off alone into the wilderness where he spent forty days asking himself the question what it meant to be Jesus. During Lent, Christians are supposed to ask one way or another what it means to be themselves."





So....What is Ash Wednesday?

On Ash Wednesday we acknowledge the beginning of the season of Lent by spending time reflecting on our mortality. When we receive ashes (often on our foreheads, but sometimes on our hands) we are reminded, "from dust you came and to dust you shall return" (Genesis 3:19). As we begin to journey through Lent, just as Jesus journeyed to the cross, we are reminded that God is our creator who loves us in life and in death.



To Give Up or Take On?

It has become a common practice during Lent to either give something up (diet coke...cough Carrie cough, social media, video games, etc.) or to add something new to our routine (writing poetry, reading, taking a daily walk, making music). You don't have to do this and if you choose to you don't have to be perfect!

The purpose is to be intentional and grow in your awareness of self, others, and God. Let us know if you're giving something up or taking something on so we can support you during Lent!
